


Oct 16th and 17th Ring Sales

On Wednesday, Ms. Brownlee took some enthusiastic Grade 10 History students to participate in an archeology dig near Quyon. The archeological dig site was the location of a former Hudson's Bay Company fur trading post which was in operation in the 1840s-50s. Three archeologists were on site to teach students how to trowel, sift, clean and sort artefacts. Students found many artefacts including pieces of clay pipe, glass, porcelain and metal objects. We also took a short walk to view the abundant number of stromatolite fossils at the shore of the Kitchissippi/Ottawa River. We are thankful to the Friends of the Chats Falls organization for inviting PHS to participate in this "living history" event and we acknowledge the Anishinaabe people who allowed us to be on their unceded territory and explore our shared local heritage.
