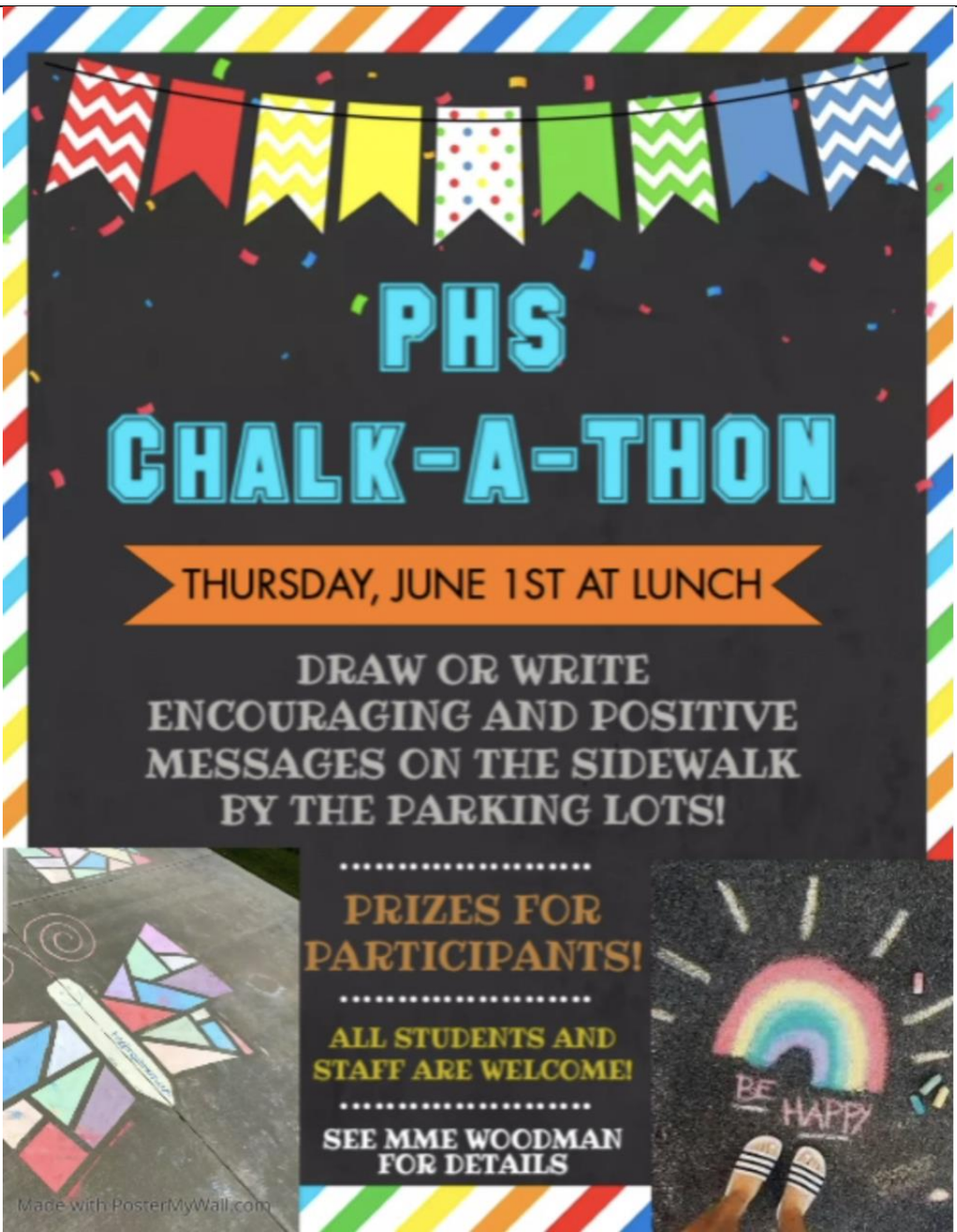
**ACADEMICS FOR GRADE 9 SCIENCE STUDENTS**

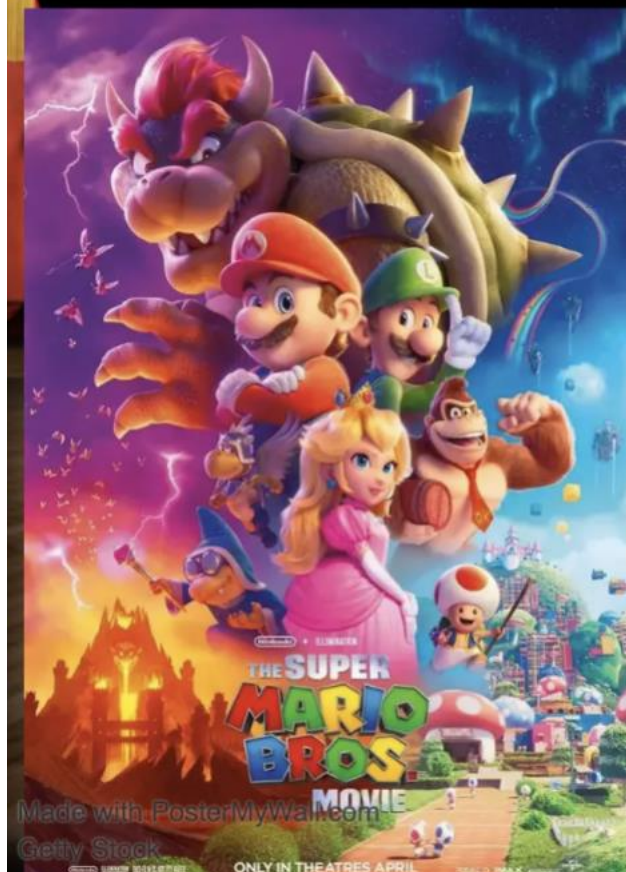
