IMPORTANT GUIDANCE ITEMS

- OPTION SHEETS (Grades 8 to 10): Elective and Arts Option Sheets are now available for next year under the dragon outside Room 214! The deadline to return Option Sheets (signed by parents) to Reception at the Main OFFICE is <u>Friday, April 12th</u>. However, since popular elective and Arts options are filled on a "first come, first served" policy, it is better to hand your sheet in ASAP. All Option Sheets are date and time stamped upon arrival at the Main Office. If you are selecting Carpentry or Welding options, remember that an <u>Application Package</u> must also be submitted to the Main Office by <u>Friday, April</u> <u>12th</u>. Application packages are also available at the table under the dragon.
 - Senior students entering Grades 10 or 11 are advised to make a meeting with their Guidance Counsellor, Ms. Brownlee, to ensure that they are selecting the correct courses needed for post-secondary College, CEGEP and University programs. Ms. Brownlee is available on Teams, Email or by sign up at the Guidance Counter in the Main Office Lobby.

2. GRADUATING STUDENTS:

- a. Quebec CEGEP applicants First Round CEGEP offers of conditional acceptance will be available via SRAM on <u>Friday, April 5th.</u> If you receive an offer, you must confirm your acceptance on your chosen CEGEP's Omnivox system, make your 1st semester course selections and pay the minimal processing fees ASAP. If you miss this short deadline, you will be in jeopardy of losing your seat in the program.
- b. Ontario College applicants The deadline to select and accept your preferred Conditional Offer <u>and</u> pay your initial Tuition Fees is <u>June 15th</u>. Failure to do so will put your program seat in jeopardy.
