## CONTEST RULES

**Judging:** All submissions will be judged according to composition, originality, and technical merit (for the photography), and content, grammar and originality (for the accompanying texts).

**Originality and Plagiarism:** Photos and accompanying texts must be entirely the work of the student. Any photo or text found to have been copied in whole or in part from the Internet or elsewhere will be disqualified.

**Subject Matter:** Photos must be of an object, person, place or event of significance to the heritage of the student's family, school, or community. Subjects must be relevant in some way to life in Quebec.

**Photographer:** Photos must be the work of the student.

**Specs:** Photos (digital only) may be submitted in either colour or black and white and must have a resolution of 300 dpi or better, and a dimension of at least 800 X 1000 pixels.

### EACH PHOTO MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FOLLOWING:

Student's name and grade  
Teacher's name  
The name, address and telephone  
number of the high school  
The title of the photo

The date and circumstance in which  
the photo was taken  
A 150-300-word text, written in the  
student's own words, describing the  
subject and why it constitutes  
"heritage"
