School Dance Information and Procedures

- Any student who is **absent from school on the day of the dance is NOT ADMITTED to the dance** that evening. The attendance sheet will be at the entrance table and teachers will be checking for this.
- **Entrance to the dance is from 6:30 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. ONLY.** If students arrive late, they will not be admitted to the dance regardless of having purchased a ticket in advance.
- **All bags, purses, coats, etc. will be stored in the Music Room.** They will not be stored in lockers.
- Once a student is admitted to the dance, he or she remains at the dance until time to go home. **There is no going outside once admitted to the dance, except when leaving.**
- To attend a dance, a student must **NOT HAVE HAD AN OUT OF SCHOOL SUSPENSION in the previous 2 calendar months** (e.g. January 2nd to March 2nd, if the dance is happening March 2nd). The list of out of school suspensions will be at the entrance table and teachers will be checking.

- **Any student who is to be late to the dance for a valid reason must provide Ms. Stephens with a note from their parent explaining why by 3:05 p.m. on Wednesday, March 1st.**
